THIS AMENDMENT, entered into between the State of Florida, Department of Children and Families, hereinafter referred to as the "Department" and <u>Broward Behavioral Health Coalition</u>, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "Provider," amends <u>Contract # JH343</u>.

Amendment #0005 added language to comply with the National Voter Registration Act.

Amendment #0006 reduced \$2,086.00 from the current fiscal year FY13-14.

Amendment #0007 moved the operational cost funds (Section A) to the services & supports provider activity (Section B.)

Amendment #0008 restated the contract to update Standard Contract and Attachments.

Amendment #0009 added \$2,018,954.00 to the current fiscal year FY14-15.

Amendment #0010 reduced \$38,693.00 from the current fiscal year FY14-15.

Amendment #0011 added \$44,118.00 to the current fiscal year FY14-15 and implemented Budget Amendment B-0126 between contract# KH225 and JH343.

Amendment #0012 reduced \$99,619.00 from the current fiscal year FY14-15.

Amendment #0013 restated the contract to update Standard Contract and Attachments.

Amendment #0014 updated language to include CSU database requirements, removed Most Favored Party Status requirement, and add EOG/OPB reporting requirements.

Amendment #0015 added \$6,339,103.00 to the current fiscal year FY15-16.

- 1. The purpose of Amendment #0016 is to add \$66,667.00 to the current fiscal year FY15-16 of the contract. The addition is made to the Other Cost Accumulator (OCA) MHSHG in accord with the Schedule of Funds as of 02/26/2016. The purpose also is to include Incorporated Document 37 Housing Coordination; update Exhibit E, ME Schedule of Funds; and to update Exhibit F, Region Specific Provisions to amend in language for Specific Appropriation 377J to rename as Women's Special Funding and to include Incorporated Document 38 Women's Special Funding.
- 2. Page 1, Standard Legacy Contract, Section 3., dated 05/2014, Payment for Services is hereby amended to read:
 - 3. Payment for Services. The Department shall pay for contracted services performed by the Provider during the service performance period of this Contract according to the terms and conditions of this Contract of an amount not to exceed \$173,804,673.07 or the rate schedule, subject to the availability of funds and the Department's determination of satisfactory performance of all terms by the Provider. The State of Florida's performance and obligation to pay under this Contract is contingent upon an annual appropriation by the Legislature. Any costs or services paid for under any other contract or from any other source are not eligible for payment under this Contract.
- 3. Page 24, Attachment I, Section B.2., Staffing, Paragraph c.(6) is hereby inserted and attached hereto:
 - (6) One FTE of the Managing Entity staff shall serve as Housing Coordinator, in compliance with the provisions of Incorporated Document 37 Housing Coordination, which is incorporated herein by reference.
- **4.** Page 29, Attachment I, Section B.6.Managing Entity Responsibilities, Paragraph b.(5) is hereby inserted and attached hereto:
 - (5) The Managing Entity shall provide the housing coordination function specified in Incorporated Document 37 Housing Coordination with Network Service Providers, local housing and homelessness stakeholders, and the Local Community Providers of Services identified at the Department's Office on Homelessness webpage at:

 - 1. Specific Appropriation 377J Women's Special Funding

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 377J, the recurring sum of \$1,043,188.00 from the General Revenue fund is provided for the expansion of substance abuse services for pregnant women and their affected families. These services shall include the expansion of residential treatment, outpatient treatment with housing support, outreach, detoxification, child care and post-partum case management supporting both the mother and child consistent with recommendations from the Statewide Task Force on Prescription Drug Abuse and Newborns. Priority for services shall be given to counties with greatest need and available treatment capacity.

The Managing Entity shall subcontract with the Network Service Providers for this funding as listed in Table A. These services shall be provided in compliance with Incorporated Document 38 – Women's Special Funding. With the submission of the Final Fiscal Year Invoice, the Managing Entity will submit a report that details for each provider the sub contractual amount, actual amount paid, and total units purchased. This report shall also contain the total of any anticipated carry forward funds of Specific Appropriation 377J. These anticipated carry forward funds will also be included on Incorporated Document 27: Managing Entity Carry Forward Expenditure Report.

This amendment shall begin on <u>March 1, 2016</u> or the date on which the amendment has been signed by both parties, whichever is later.

All provisions in the contract and any attachments thereto in conflict with this amendment shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this amendment.

All provisions not in conflict with this amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the level specified in the contract.

This amendment and all its attachments are hereby made a part of the contract.
