C2-11 Fiscal Year 2020-21 Appropriations

Pursuant to the FY20-21 General Appropriations Act, Ch. 2020-114 Laws of Fla., the Managing Entity shall implement the following, summarized in **Table 1h**:

C2-11.1 Specific Appropriation 370 – CAT Teams

Funds provided in Specific Appropriation 370 shall be used to subcontract with the providers in **Table 1h** for the operation of Community Action Treatment (CAT) teams, per the terms of **Guidance 32**. The recurring base appropriation projects in are funded from general revenue funds

C2-11.2 Specific Appropriation 371 Projects

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 371, the following projects are funded from recurring general revenue funds:

- C2-11.2.1 Henderson Behavioral Health Forensic treatment services... 1,622,235
- C2-11.2.2 Supported employment services for individuals with mental health disorders as detailed in Table 1h.

C2-11.3 Specific Appropriation 373 Projects

C2-11.3.1 Family Intensive Treatment Funding

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 373, General Revenue Fund is provided to implement the Family Intensive Treatment (FIT) team model designed to provide intensive team-based, family-focused, comprehensive services to families in the child welfare system with parental substance abuse. The Managing Entity shall execute and manage subcontracts for these services in accordance with **Guidance 18**.

C2-11.3.2 Women's Special Funding

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 373, General Revenue Fund shall continue to be provided for the expansion of substance abuse services for pregnant women, mothers, and their affected families. These services shall include the expansion of residential treatment, outpatient treatment with housing support, outreach, detoxification, child care and post-partum case management supporting both the mother and child consistent with recommendations from the Statewide Task Force on Prescription Drug Abuse and Newborns. Priority for services shall be given to counties with the greatest need and available treatment capacity.

C2-11.4 Specific Appropriation 376 Project

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 376, \$500,000 from the Federal Grants Trust Fund using federal funds received from the State Opioid Response Grant is provided to Memorial Healthcare System for Medication Assisted Treatment Community Expansion (HB 4303) (Senate Form 1619).
