- **Welcome and Introductions**

Mr. Paul Jaquith called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. Attendance was taken via Microsoft Teams.

- **Meeting Minutes**

Mr. Rick Riccardi made a motion to approve the February 11, 2022 meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Joanne Correia- Kent and the minutes were unanimously approved.

- **Outcomes/Data- Carisk**

- Ms. Jennifer Branham stated that providers can review their Score Card to see if they are passing their performance measures or to see if they are missing data points. Providers can reach out to Carisk for any assistance needed. Ms. Branham stated that Carisk will be moving to a ticket system to help address providers' technical issues in a timelier manner.
- Ms. Caren Longworth stated that as a network, we are failing the *Adult in Mental Health Crisis who live in stable housing* measure, and she urged providers to review their data input. Not enough data for two of the children's data measures has been captured, therefore this performance measure has not been met either.

- **Zero Suicide Initiative Update**

- Mr. Paul Jaquith introduced the new LOSS Team Director, Mr. Rafis Nin. Mr. Nin will be leading the local outreach to survivors of suicide team, and this team will link survivors to resources and support groups.
- Mr. Jaquith provided an update about the Lethal Means Group. He was able to secure a presentation at a Gun Club and members of the club offered to volunteer.

- **Suicide Academy**
 - Mr. Nin mentioned that the Academy encourages providers to collaborate with the Zero Suicide Initiative to reduce the number of suicides across the Provider Network.
 - Mr. Jaquith set up a subcommittee meeting after a discussion amongst providers regarding suicide prevention. The subcommittee will report back to the Provider Advisory Council regarding evidence-based practices such as CBT trainings and how best to help the community.
- **BBHC Updates**
 - **Pre-qualifications**

Ms. Silvia Quintana stated that BBHC is currently in the process of reviewing five providers, that are part of the Broward County school system's network, to contract and provide services to children with mental and behavioral illnesses.

Children's Care Coordination Plan Workgroups

Ms. Elida Segrera announced that a stake holder meeting was held, and it helped re-engage providers. It will establish work groups focused on children's crisis, systems integration, and prevention/early intervention, so individuals are served before an issue escalates to a crisis. Providers were encouraged to email Ms. Segrera if they are interested in joining the workgroups.
 - **988 Update**

Ms. Silvia Quintana stated that all of the managing entities are submitting their funding requests to Tallahassee, that will be appropriated from \$126 million that is pending the governor's veto. BBHC reviewed the proviso that came with the funding appropriation, and will prioritize those projects first, and then ask for what the enhancement plans need to buy back capacity and to fund MRT Teams.
- **Work Force Development**

Ms. Vivian Demille discussed the difficulties of hiring and on-boarding new staff due to potential employees taking other jobs. The sub-committee wants to create a survey monkey to get feedback from the providers to identify areas of concerns, including questions regarding direct care and regulatory requirements, ideas on how to improve hiring practices and retention, and comparing salaries to gauge a standard in the industry.
- **New/Other Business**
 - Epic Awards

Mr. Paul Jaquith reminded council members that the in-person Epic Awards will be held on May 25th, 2022 at the Signature Grand.
 - Behavioral Health Conference

Mr. Paul Jaquith stated that the Behavioral Health Conference will be held on May 10th and 11th with a pre-conference day on May 9th for faith-based leaders to be educated about behavioral health services.
