Work Location: Broward Behavioral Health Coalition

Position Reports to: Senior Director of Children System of Care

Position Status: Full Time / Exempt \$60,000 (Annually)

Description of Duties and Responsibilities:

- a. Works with the Senior Director of Children System of Care to engage children and parents into mental health services and supports
- b. Processes referrals for children referred from the school system who need mental health services
- c. Provides service coordination for children and families
- d. Provides quality management to network service providers to ensure that children and families receive quality services
- e. Attends trainings and conferences on behavioral health as continued education
- f. Participates in committee meetings and staffings as necessary
- g. Attends all trainings and meetings associated with the system of care transformation and the school system as necessary
- h. Participate in outreach activities and resource fairs as necessary

Skills and Knowledge:

- a. **Professional Skills –** Excellent verbal and written communication; ability to engage children and families in a professional and encouraging manner.
- b. Education & Professional Experience A master's degree in a mental health-related field from an accredited college or university. Applicant must have knowledge of children's behavioral health and related services. Individual must have at least 2 years of professional experience in the behavioral health field working with SED children and families.
- c. Language Skills Ability to fluently read, write and speak in English. Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form. Bi-lingual in Spanish, Creole or Portuguese is a plus.
- d. Professionalism: Approaches others in a tactful and professional manner, reacts well under pressure, follows through on commitments, accepts responsibility for own actions.

Qualifications:

- a. The Care Coordinator must have exceptional organizational, administration, and time management skills.
- b. This individual has a working knowledge of Broward County's children's system of care.
- c. Preferred applicant has direct clinical experience and knowledge regarding the service, clinical and treatment needs of severely emotionally disturbed (SED) children.

Travel:

a. Ability to travel to trainings, meetings and conferences as necessary.

Mental and Physical Qualifications:

Good health as evidenced by acceptable employment health screening, ability to function effectively under stressful circumstances, and acceptable attendance record.

Other Qualifications:

Has a valid driver's license and acceptable driving record. Will consent to drug testing and background screening processes as required by the State, based on holding this position of special trust to include a fingerprint-based search of criminal records in Florida and nationally.
